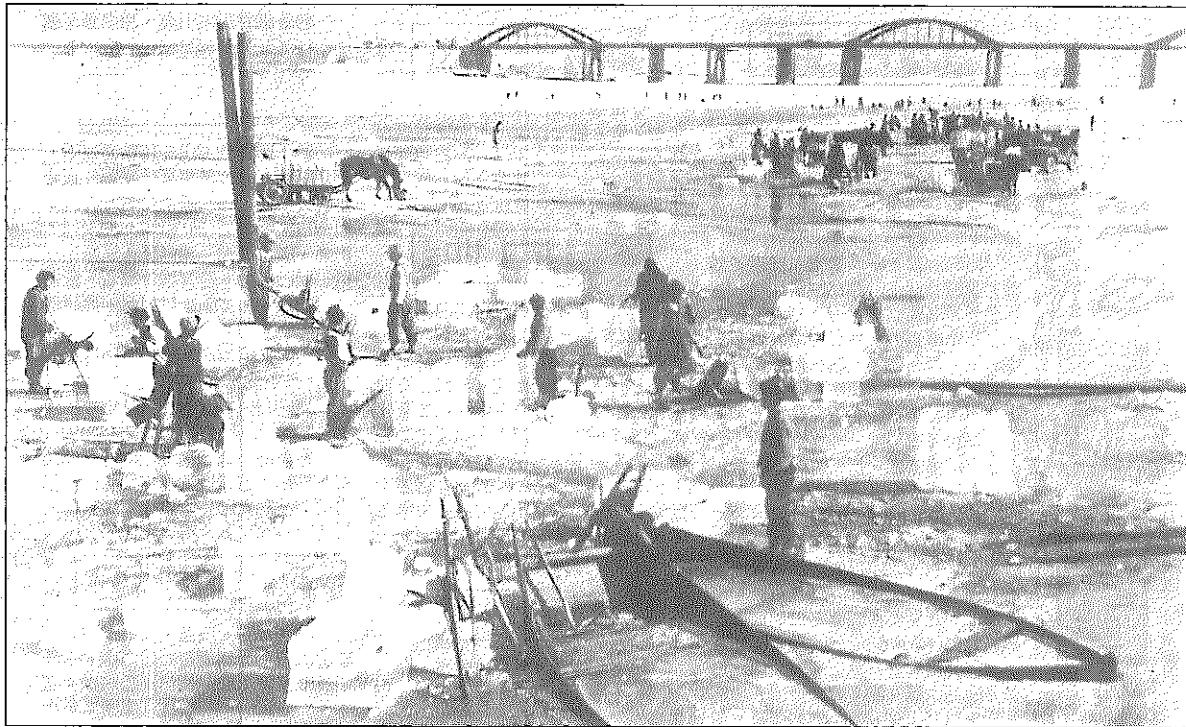


ICE CUTTING IN KOREA

Enterprising Koreans cut ice in big chunks from the Han River at Seoul. Ice will be stored for use this summer.



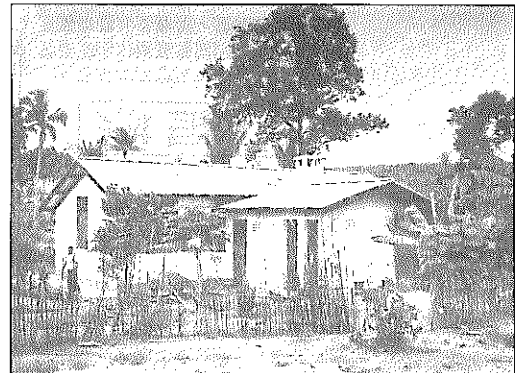
